OVERVIEW

Department of Electronics, Information Technology, Biotechnology and Science & Technology, Government of Karnataka organized **24th edition** of **Bengaluru Tech Summit** between **17th to 19th November 2021** Bengaluru Tech Summit, is a unified platform for India's two pioneering events; Bengaluru ITE.Biz and Bengaluru India Bio. The Vice President's presence and inspiring words encouraged us to deliver nothing but the best during the three days. Further, we were honoured by the virtual presence of **Shri. Scott Morrison, Hon'ble Prime Minister of Australia and Shri. Naftali Bennett, Hon'ble Prime Minister of Israel.**

The three-day event was packed with 75 sessions with 343 speakers, attended by 26,863 registered business delegates. The new features added this year included India USA Tech Conclave, India Innovation Alliance, Bengaluru Next Conclave with Leadership Conclave and Startup conclave and showcase of Science Gallery.

Around 50,000 people viewed the Inaugural, Plenary, Conference, Awards, and Quizzes as well as to view the exhibition and on-demand sessions. This was truly an international event that saw participation from 48 countries with 1253 international delegates and 3 Minister level international delegations. The virtual exhibition had 340 booths which witnessed more than 11,000 interactions with the visitors. 211 start-ups from across various sectors showcased their products/services at the expo.

We had the Leadership Conclave that was attended by more than 115 CEOs to discuss the role of the IT industry to achieve India's 5 trillion-dollar economy. The start-ups that became Unicorns in the year 2020-21 were felicitated during the Innovator's conclave and also had a very interesting panel discussion with the leaders from the industry.

The conclave had a very interesting panel discussion that was moderated by Mr. Chetan Bhagat, Author and Columnist. The panellists included Shri. Prashanth Prakash, Partner, Accel and Chairman, Vision Group on Startups, GoK; Mr. Harshil Mathur, Founder, Razorpay, Mr. Lingraju Sawkar, President, Kyndryl India; Mr. Sujeet Kumar, Co-Founder, Udaan; and Dr. C. N. Ashwath Narayan, Hon'ble Minister for Electronics, IT & Bt, S&T, Higher Education, Skill Development, Entrepreneurship and Livelihood, GoK too actively engaged in the discussion and shared his perspectives regarding GoK's initiatives for start-ups.

The highlight of the evening was the felicitation of start-ups that became Unicorns from Karnataka in 2020-21. The awardees shared their journey and also thanked the Govt. for all the support they have been extending.













SPECIAL PROGRAMMES

INDIA US TECH CONCLAVE

The 24th edition of the Bengaluru Tech Summit launched the India USA Tech Conclave for the first time in collaboration with the US India Business Council (USIBC). The mandate of USIBC is to facilitate Ease of Doing Business between the United States and India. USIBC connects the two largest democracies in the world and inspire sustainable solutions for business challenges — both local and global. This maiden Tech Conclave focuses on the USA and Karnataka digital opportunities, covering IT services, new media markets, geospatial, digital health technologies, and more.

Day 1 - India US Tech Conclave Focus on India's Digital Journey

The India US Tech Conclave Day 1 session was greeted by Nisha Biswal, President, USIBC. In her opening speech, she emphasized the aim of this session that drives the conversation about deeping India - US technology relationship and hoped to enable future innovation and create a lasting and impactful partnership. The session also dug into the origin of Synergies and future opportunities of the India - US digital System.

During the Keynote, Dr. C.N. Ashwath Narayan, Hon'ble Minister for Electronics, IT, Bt and S&T, Higher Education, Skill Development, Entrepreneurship and Livelihood, GoK, mentioned that India - US digital ecosystem is truly unique. It is a Broad-based, yet synergistic. It is fast-growing, attracting billions in bilateral investments and creating thousands of jobs annually. He trusted that the India-US digital journey will continue at an accelerated pace and that Bengaluru and Karnataka would remain at the center of this partnership. Ultimately, he expressed his gratitude to Dr. Kiran Mazumdhar Shaw, Executive Chairperson, Biocon Limited, and Chairperson, VGBT, GoK as she was instrumental in this collaboration with the India-US Business council.

The Conference was specially addressed by Judith Ravin, Consul General, Chennai, U.S. Department of State. In her oration, she spoke about a bilateral trade collaboration and emphasized that when it comes to business, there is no stronger partner to India than the United States. She also emphasized that India's economic strength is not just in India's interest but the interest of the United States, the region and the world.

The Session had a 90-minute Panel Discussion titled 'India's Digital Journey: From Outsourcing Hub to Innovation Central' which was Moderated by Jitendra Chaddah, Country Manager, Global Supply Chain, Intel India, and remarkable panelists - Day Veerlapati, President and CEO, S2Tech, from BPOs to R&D Design; Biju Baby, VP, Integration, Development, Equinix India and Arya Barirani from Innovative IT services; CMO GlobalLogic + Method, Biplab Adhya, Managing Partner, Wipro Ventures and Jubal Harpster, Vice President, Geospatial — Cyient from Innovative IT services; Medha Jaishankar, Senior Producer, JetSynthesys and Vijay Sundaram, Chief Strategy Office, Zoho from Branded products, content and gaming.

This discussion provided insights into India's digital journey - a transition that will propel the global digital community; an ecosystem with unique U.S - India synergies ranging from STEM education to venture capital; a commercial community bound by long-standing relationships, increased investment, and new market and segments. Thus, the India - US digital journey continues apace with no end in sight except for the ability to re-imagine a digital future. Jay Gullish, USIBC thanked all the Panelists and experts in his closing remarks.





The symposium yielded a huge range of ideas and suggestions for future opportunities, Aero innovations, Technology, Creation, and delivery. It captured India's journey - from Y2K debugging that was based on the ability to offer cost-effective technical resources at scale to her transformation into a hub of innovations and creativity.

Day 2 - India US Tech Conclave Focus on Life Science

The second day of the India US Tech Conclave was addressed by Nisha Biswal, President, USIBC. The discussion on life science was to underscore an equally dramatic change from cost-efficiency around generics, to the focus on advanced Pharmaceuticals, Robotics, Vaccine research, and other innovative technologies.

Dr. Shekhar C. Mande, Secretary, DSIR and Director General, CSIR delivered the Keynote address. He provided an overview of the current situation and how both the US and India have achieved a large number of innovations during the pandemic. He also highlighted that the government of India has launched the National Digital Health Mission which aims to integrate tests, diagnosis, and treatments.

The conference had a 105-minute Panel Discussion titled 'Accelerating Innovation and R&D development in the U.S - India economic corridor and Developments in Health towards a Safer World'. This panel discussion featured Dr. Trevor Mundel, President Global Health, Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, Dr. Carl June, Director of the Parker Institute for Cancer Immunotherapy at the University of Pennsylvania, MD, and Preetha Rajaraman, Health Attaché, U.S. Embassy. It was moderated by Dr. Kiran Mazumdar Shaw, Executive Chairperson, Biocon. They discussed the current state of healthcare innovation and areas for collaboration between the United States and India. The discussion explored what was needed from both the public and private sectors to enable deeper collaboration, and fortify the world against future pandemics and public health emergencies.

In this discussion, they talked about their journey, problems faced in the area of healthcare, and the distance between a successful product in the lab and a successful product in the marketplace. This discussion provided several ideas and suggestions for future innovations in healthcare.

In addition, the conference had a TED-style talk on "Robotics in Surgery" by Dr. Bill Peine, Senior Director Systems Architecture – Surgical Robotics, Medtronic. In his presentation, he spoke about how robots help with surgery, the evolution of surgery driven by transformational technology, the evolution of surgical robotics, the HUGO system, Four vectors for the future of surgical robotics, Robotic systems and instruments, User interface & Human-centered design and the future of surgery.

Both countries have a keen mutual interest in fostering and expanding the next generation of talent. The US-India conclave highlighted a common approach and cultural market access so that both nations can employ their strategic positions to advance shared initiatives in international trade negotiations and provide a strong example of global cooperation between a developed and emerging economy. The deliberation from the Policymakers and scientists from the United States and India conveyed their interest to forge a strong collaboration with R&D institutions and industries of both countries and help nurture startup ecosystem forge more meaningful ties building upon each other's strengths






