PROCEEDINGS OF GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: Implementation of Karnataka Tourism Policy 2020-25.

Read: Government Order No. PraE 81 Pravayo 2014 dated 26.03.2015

PREAMBLE:-

In the Government Order read above, Karnataka Tourism Policy 2015-20 was introduced. The period of the Policy has ended on 26.03.2020.

Karnataka is the most preferred tourism destination that provides a safe and memorable experience for tourists through diverse high-quality tourism offerings developed in collaboration with tourism stakeholders and local communities to create sustainable and inclusive socioeconomic development for all.

As the logo of Karnataka tourism says it all "One State, Many Worlds", Karnataka Tourism is home for varied tourism themes including heritage, culture, eco-tourism, wildlife, spiritual, adventure, coastal, wellness and agri. tourism in urban and rural areas. Tourism is a priority sector for the Government of Karnataka and the State has undertaken significant investments for the development and promotion of tourism. In 2018, Karnataka ranked 3rd among all Indian states for domestic tourist visits, attracting more than 21.50 crore visitors or 12% of overall domestic tourists visits in India. Additionally, the State ranked 11th for international tourist visits in India, attracting nearly 5.5 lakh foreign tourists.

Implementation of Karnataka Tourism Policy 2020-25 envisages to boost the tourism industry in State by increasing domestic and international visitations, offering high quality experience to visitors, facilitating and accelerating investments and improving livelihood opportunities at the local level.

It is imperative for the state government to periodically review their existing tourism policy and in the backdrop of the extent to which the existing policy has been able to achieve its objectives. The main purpose of the Karnataka Tourism Policy 2020-25 is to comprehensively develop Karnataka Tourism which includes:

- 1. Promote Karnataka as an attractive tourism destination and place it prominently on the domestic and global tourism map.
- Develop tourism as a significant driver of inclusive socio-economic development for Karnataka.
- Augment the development of robust tourism infrastructure across Karnataka by providing world-class experience to visitors through a diverse array of high-quality products and services.
- 4. Ensure coordinated and active involvement of all stakeholders for the improvement of tourism in Karnataka.
- 5. Provide a conducive business environment with investment-friendly policies to encourage private sector participation in the tourism sector.

The objectives of Karnataka Tourism Policy 2020-25 are -

- 1. To harness Karnataka's tourism potential for its effects on employment generation and economic development.
- 2. To instil confidence in tourists to visit Karnataka and ensure their comfort, convenience, and safety throughout their journey in Karnataka.
- 3. To promote Karnataka in domestic and international markets through a multitude of marketing channels.
- 4. To ensure quality tourism infrastructure and basic amenities for tourists at and en-route to major tourism destinations across Karnataka.
- 5. To create an enabling framework for private sector investments and establish mechanisms to support industry-driven initiatives in tourism.
- 6. To encourage sustainable development in tourism towards achievement of the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals for Karnataka.

Incentives, Subsidies and Concessions under Karnataka Tourism Policy 2020-25

The Karnataka Tourism Policy provides a wide range of incentives, subsidies and concessions for Tourism Projects and Tourism Service Providers. The eligibility of Tourism Projects for various Incentives, Subsidies and Concessions is provided in Annexure-II.

- Interest Subsidy for Agri Tourism Project, Cultural Tourism Project, Heritage Tourism Project, Safety and Hygiene Tourism Project

Concessions

- o Exemption on Stamp Duty
- o Concessional Registration Charges
- o Reimbursement of Land Conversion Fee
- o Exemption on Motor Vehicle Tax
- o Complementary Infrastructure Assistance

A separate guideline by competent authority for development of tourism projects under various tourism products and service categories is required to be issued. Compliance with the guidelines would be necessary to be eligible for availing off concessions and investment subsidies under the policy.

Government has decided to include the above points/details and publish Tourism Policy. Hence the following order.

In the circumstances explained above, approval of Government is accorded for the Karnataka Tourism Policy 2020-25 as appended to this Order and to implement along with the incentives, subsidies and concession mentioned in the said policy. This Tourism Policy will be in force for a period of 05 years from the date of issue of this Order.

Separate guidelines will be issued by the competent authority for development of tourism projects under various tourism products and service categories listed in the Policy.

Operational guidelines on the various incentives, subsidies and concession available under the policy will be issued separately.

A separate guidelines/Orders/Notifications with regard-to the facilitation support and concessions as mentioned in the Karnataka Tourism Policy 2020-25 to be provided by concerned Departments in respect of Tourism projects shall be issued separately by the respective
