Workshop 2 Overview:

Enrich 2.0: Capacity Building Workshop was co-hosted by Startup Karnataka and ARTPARK. Representatives from state-supported incubators attended the program.

The discussions focused on empowering startup incubators and helping them evaluate the startups on the basis of Performance Indicators like Financial Health, Networking Scope etc. The program further helped the incubators gain a perspective on technology commercialization strategies required to take ideas to the market, and about funding opportunities for student-led startups. The overview of each session is as follows:

1. Session: Nurturing Startups of Tomorrow: Incubator Administration and Management

Speaker: Ms Kritika Murgesan (Director, NASSCOM)

The session focussed on helping participants understand the basis of the key indicator which any startup is evaluated. Ms Kritika shared her experiences on NASSCOM 10K Startups, and how entrepreneurship can be encouraged in India, given the opportunities in the country.

2. Panel Discussion: From the Research Labs to the Market: Defining Technology Commercialization strategies

Speakers: Mr Navratan Katariya (Director-Innovation, K-tech NASSCOM), Raj Waghray (Head - Entrepreneurship Cell SID, IISc), Subhashis Banerjee (Chief Investment Officer, ARTPARK)

The panel discussion enabled participants to think about the feasibility of commercialization strategies while evaluating a startup. For any startup, and in turn, any incubator to be profitable, the technology proposed needs to transition from the research lab to the market. The discussion brought to light the various activities that an incubator can undertake to facilitate accelerated technology commercialization.

3. Session: Financial Management and Raising funds from the Government

Speaker: Mr Sathyanarayana B V (CEO, AIC-Great Lakes Balachandran Incubator)

In this interactive session hosted by Mr Sathyanarayana, participants got a better understanding of the financial prospects available to them in order to fund different startups. The discussions also highlighted the different factors that need to be considered while providing financial support to a startup.

4. Session: Funding opportunities for student-led startups

Speaker: Mr Manjesh Basavarajaiah (CAO, Campus Fund)

Campus Fund is an incubator for student-led startups in India. Its uniqueness lies in the fact that it not only funds student-led start-ups but is in fact run by full-time students. Mr Manjesh spoke about the opportunities available for student entrepreneurs, and the model that they follow to support startups.

Workshop 2 Outcome:

- 1. Knowledge Enhancement: Helping incubators develop a strong support program by covering important aspects of incubation like technology commercialization, financial management and incubator administration.
- 2. Support Management: Helping incubators with requisite support infrastructure and training for startups.
- 3. Process Enhancement: Helping incubators build an efficient model to enable sustained growth.
- 4. Networking: Enabling the incubators to build a robust network by making connections with mentors, investors, and other ecosystem stakeholders.

Role of Startup Karnataka in Workshop 2:

Department of Electronics, IT, BT being the Nodal Department for Startups in the State have played a key role in designing, coordinating, and hosting the sensitization workshop in collaboration ARTPARK, who supported in planning and implementing the workshop.
